

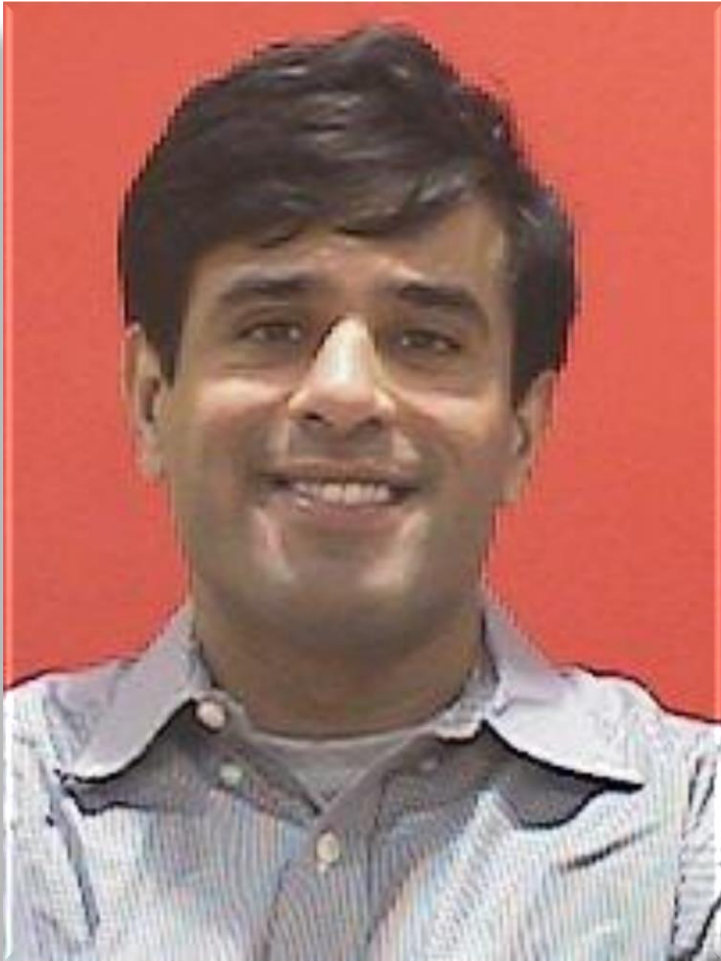
# **UT Southwestern / Children's Medical Center - Dallas Pediatric PL-3 House Staff, 2020-2021**

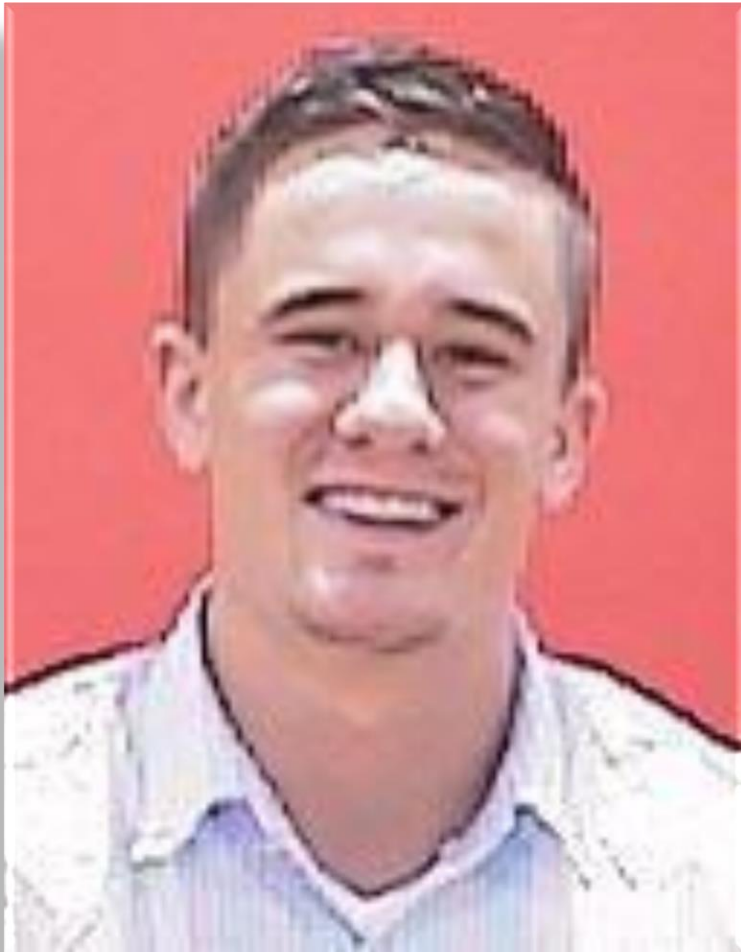
