Emergency and Crisis Mental health Services

Emergency Evaluation and Treatment:

Psychiatric hospitals evaluate and when needed provide 24 hour care for kids and teens that need a safe and healing environment. Some offer Partial Hospital (PHP) or Intensive Outpatient (IOP) Programs. General hospitals also see children in their emergency rooms for medical problems and can provide mental health evaluations if needed.

Mobile Crisis Outreach Teams (MCOTs) offer face to face evaluations to people going through a crisis in the community 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The goal of this kind of evaluation is to understand if a person is in danger to find the best possible mental health services to keep them safe and help them get better.

Crisis Hotlines give emotional support and help to people in the community going through a crisis 24 hours a day, 7 days a week by phone or text.
