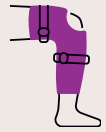

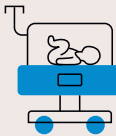
Two on-campus specialty centers offer a full spectrum of services in pediatric specialties and subspecialties

expanding care for kids

When we first broke ground on the Children's Medical Center Plano campus in October 2005, we did so with the promise to care for the children in our community and to grow alongside them. On Oct. 26, 2021, we reaffirmed our promise as we broke ground on an expansion that will allow us to provide enhanced specialty care to the children of today, tomorrow and many future generations. By late 2024, Children's Health will open a new tower at the Plano hospital, a development that will ultimately nearly triple the number of beds and significantly enhance clinical capabilities.
